# Why have a team scholarship program?

- Reward athletes who exemplify your club's values
- Reward athletes who are committed to your club
- Improved access to post-secondary education
- Provide opportunity for those that may need financial assistance
- Motivate athletes to pursue higher education
- Engage your supporters in a larger cause
- Support your community

#### How it Works




- A scholarship fund can be started with a small donation and a pledge to raise \$25,000 within five year.
- Donations are NEVER SPENT, they are invested and only a portion
   of the investment income is used to generate Scholarships each year.
- Your club picks students to receive a scholarship each year and informs the Foundation.
- The Foundation forwards scholarship funds directly to the Postsecondary institution to offset tuition fees for the selected student.

#### Donations




- Individuals, organizations, or groups can donate via credit card through the Foundations donation portal.
- The Foundation can accept gifts of cheques, cash/credit cards, appreciated securities, life-insurance, or a bequest.
- The Foundation produces charitable receipts and manages all CRA reporting.
- Clubs can fundraise and build their fund over time
- Encourage your supporters to make annual contributions to your fund.

# Scholarships



- Your Scholarship fund grants about 4.5% of its value each year to support a student athlete of your choice.
  - A \$25,000 fund generates a \$1,000 annual scholarship
  - A \$75,000 fund generates a \$3,000 annual scholarship
- Excess investment returns are retained and reinvested to grow your fund organically over time.
- Retained earnings can be used to pay for Scholarships in years when the market underperforms.

## Case Study



- The Mississauga Terriers and a private donor started the Joe Schembri Scholarship Fund in 2005, with an initial donation of \$40,000.
- Since 2005, the fund has supported more than 20 Terriers in their pursuit of higher education.
- The fund has granted more than \$40,000 in Scholarships to date.
- The initial donation has never been spent and when combined with retained earnings, the fund has a current balance of over \$60,000.
