Red Shawl Women's Community Organization - G-class drivers education support for newcomer women with less than two years in Canada

For many newcomer women, driving represents more than just mobility — it's freedom, confidence, and the key to new opportunities.

Through the Drive and Thrive program, the Red Shawl Women's Community Organization is helping women who've been in Canada for less than two years gain that independence. Supported by The Mississauga Foundation's Newcomers Fund, the initiative provides full reimbursement for G-class driver's education, including 20 hours of classroom learning, 10 hours of in-car training, and preparation for the G2 road test.

But this program goes beyond driving lessons — it's about empowerment. By helping women gain the skills to navigate their new communities safely and independently, Drive and Thrive is paving the way toward brighter, more confident futures.
