I Challenge Diabetes - Expanding Diabetes Education

I Challenge Diabetes (ICD) empowers people living with Type 1 Diabetes (T1D) through mentorship, adventure programs, school-based initiatives, and community events. By providing experiential education in real-world, active settings, ICD helps participants build confidence and develop practical skills to manage their health.

Through one-on-one and group mentorship, individuals connect with peers who have lived experience with T1D, fostering a supportive and non-judgmental community. ICD's adventure programs, from local hikes and paddles to multi-day wilderness expeditions, challenge participants to push past perceived limitations, promoting resilience, independence, and self-efficacy.

By combining education, peer support, and adventure, ICD creates meaningful opportunities for people with T1D to thrive, connect, and take charge of their health.

Jennifer Ashleigh Children's Charity - Financial Relief for low income children with serious medical needs

The Jennifer Ashleigh Children's Charity (JenAsh) provides vital financial relief to low-income Ontario families with children facing serious medical needs. By covering costs not met by government programs—such as housing and meal support, transportation, medications, medical supplies, and therapy fees—JenAsh helps families focus on what matters most: their child's health and well-being.

Through this support, families experience reduced financial stress, improved access to essential care, and the reassurance that they are not facing medical challenges alone. JenAsh's work ensures that children receive the treatment and resources they need to thrive, while families gain hope, stability, and a sense of security during difficult times.

Peel Crime Stoppers - Community Safety and Well Being. Promoting TIPS Line for Crime Prevention and Crime Solving

Peel Crime Stoppers is a community-based, non-profit charity dedicated to promoting safety and well-being in Brampton, Mississauga, Caledon, and Pearson International Airport. The organization provides an anonymous TIPS line, allowing citizens to report information about crimes without revealing their identity or appearing in court.

By offering a secure, confidential system—with follow-up via a secret code—Peel Crime Stoppers encourages community members to share information that can prevent crime and assist law enforcement in solving cases. In many instances, tips provided through this program have led to arrests, safer neighbourhoods, and even cash rewards for participants.

Through this innovative approach, Peel Crime Stoppers strengthens community trust, empowers residents to take part in public safety, and plays a critical role in keeping Peel Region safe.
