

Guidelines - Grant Applications

Pendle Fund

Eligible Organizations:

- Registered charitable status with the Canada Revenue Agency (CRA)
- Not-for-Profit organizations can partner with a Registered Charity to apply, but only the Registered Charity can submit the application as the lead applicant.
- Organizations must deliver programs and services to Mississauga Residents.

Open to all Registered Charities including:

- Arts, Culture and Heritage
- Children and Youth
- Education
- Environment
- Indigenous
- Physical and Mental Health
- Social Services
- Sports and Recreation

Smart and Caring Children and Youth Fund

Eligible Organizations:

- Registered charitable status with the Canada Revenue Agency (CRA)
- Not-for-Profit organizations including federal and/or provincial corporations
- Organizations that are solely "children-focused," meaning their primary mandate/mission is directly linked to the well-being, education, or development of individuals 24 years and under.
- If the organization's mission falls outside of the above definition, they may still be eligible to apply if they have established ongoing programs that specifically serve children and youth 24 years and under (i.e. summer camps).
- Priority will be given to organizations with total revenues below \$1.5 million and less than \$500K in unrestricted reserves.
- Organizations must deliver programs and services to Mississauga Residents.

Hazel McCallion Fund for Arts, Culture and Heritage

Eligible Organizations:

- Registered charitable status with the Canada Revenue Agency (CRA)
- Not-for-Profit organizations can partner with a Registered Charity to apply, but only the Registered Charity can submit the application as the lead applicant.
- Arts, culture and/or heritage focused organizations whose core mission and operations are primarily dedicated to the creation, presentation, preservation, and/or dissemination of arts, culture, and heritage.
- Priority will be given to organizations with total revenues below \$1.5 million and less than \$500K in unrestricted reserves.
- Organizations must deliver programs and services to Mississauga Residents.

Ineligible Projects:

For all Grant Streams, the following projects will not qualify for funding:

- Deficit Reduction
- On-going operating expenses more than 5% of requested grant amount
- Fundraising events or campaigns and salaries in support of them
- Political or religious activities (religious organizations are eligible to apply, however the project cannot be religious in nature)
- Individuals
- Sponsorships
- Scholarships or bursaries
- Retroactive funding for any project expenses to be incurred prior to the Foundation's decision date
- Debt retirement or reserves, mortgage pay-downs
- Programs and services delivered outside of Mississauga
- Advocacy/Lobbying
- Re-Granting
 - E.g. Projects requesting grants that will be directly redistributed to individuals or organizations.
- Capital (funding for tangible, brick-and-mortar, or major equipment assets)
- Capacity Building (funding for organizational systems, skills, and operational sustainability etc.)
